Dear Parents and Carers,

Christmas Showtimes/ Key Dates

I am writing to share important dates and some slight changes to our Christmas Shows this year, please ensure you only attend the year group your child is in to ensure we keep below the maximum people allowed in the hall at one time. Each child will have 2 seats per performance allocated. This means that split parents can attend either show and grandparents could come to one and parent to another.

Can we request that you only attend one of the events for your child also and please, wherever possible, leave smaller children (in pushchairs etc.) with a family member at home so the shows can take place uninterrupted. We understand this may not always be possible so will allow parents with prams to sit near doors to be able to remove crying babies when needed and use the hallway/office space.

We do allow photographs to be taken of pupils in shows, but we ask that you ensure any faces in the background or part of the picture are removed/blanked out before sharing with anyone else. This is to respect the wishes of any parents who do not want their children sharing online. Please ensure your phones are switched to silent/do not disturb mode before the show.

<u>Christmas Fair</u>: Thursday 20th November 3.30pm onwards – please come to the playground for stalls where pupils will be selling their items created as part of their Design technology this half term. Some stalls will be in the hall too so come along and have a look around. All proceeds go towards improving the school and class library areas.

<u>Christmas Lunch</u>: Wednesday 10th December – Our school catering service will be providing a hot Christmas Dinner on this day for all pupils who either receive free school meals or pay for them.
